WARNING: AVOID SERIOUS INJURY FROM FALLING OR SLIDING OUT. ALWAYS USE THE RECLINER SUPPORT SYSTEM 5-POINT HARNESS. NEVER LEAVE OCCUPANT UNATTENDED.

GENERAL INFORMATION & SAFETY

- Follow all instructions carefully. Incorrect use can cause damage to Recliner Support System.
- IMPORTANT: The 5-Point Positioning Harness must be correctly installed and adjusted before using the Recliner Support System. See Page 18 for instructions.
- Occupant should always be properly secured with the included 5-Point Harness whenever using the Recliner Support System.
- Never leave occupant unattended.
- Never allow occupant to stand on any part of the Recliner Support System.
- Never leave the Recliner Support System exposed to direct sunlight or close to heat sources, e.g. a radiator or open flame.

CARE AND CLEANING

 Before each use, ensure that all product straps are in good working order and show no signs of fraying.

CLEANING

- The Recliner Support System may be cleaned using a damp cloth with mild detergent. Always air-dry the Recliner Support System before use or storage.
- In order to machine-wash the Recliner Support System, refer to Page 20 for detailed washing instructions.
- Store Recliner Support System in a cool, dry location.
 Never fold or store the Recliner Support System if the product is not completely dry.

Intended Use










Assembly Recliner Drape & Base Fabric



1. Place
Recliner
Chair in
fully-reclined
position
and center
Recliner
Drape across
Recliner
Chair seat
and arms.



Ensure back edge of **Recliner Drape** is flush with rear edge of the Recliner Chair armrests.

2. Place Base Fabric over Recliner Drape. Be sure to align Velcro strips on bottom of the Base Fabric with matching Velcro strips on top of Recliner Drape.



3. Attach
Seat Bight
Securement
Strap to the
Base Fabric
Velcro patch
as shown
here.




4. Move Recliner Chair into fully upright position.

Always place Securement Strap Pads along the edges of the Recliner Chair, as shown here. This protects the Recliner Chair surface material from potential wear.

Crotch Strap

Note: Both a Small and Large 5-Point Harness are included with the Recliner Support System. Choose the harness size that best fits the occupant.









9. Feed **Crotch Strap** buckle through center








11. Continue feeding **Waist Strap** through the Harness Loop on the opposite side of the **Base Fabric Seat Section** as shown here.



12. Feed the **Lower Chest Strap** through the same Harness Loops as the **Waist Strap**.

Strap through
the Backrest
Section
Harness Loops
as shown.
Choose
Harness Loops
slightly above
the occupant's
expected
shoulder
height.



Assembly Fabric Liner Pad

Fabric Liner Pad

14. Ensure Recliner Chair is in the fully-reclined position.



15. Align Velcro at the top of the **Fabric Liner Pad** with Velcro at the top of the **Base Fabric Backrest Section.**



16. Feed ends of Shoulder Strap, Waist Strap, Lower Chest Strap, and Crotch Strap through corresponding slits in Fabric Liner Pad.



17. Align Velcro at the bottom of **Fabric Liner Pad** with the Velcro at the edge of the **Base Fabric Seat Section.**



If using optional Soft-Touch® Cushions, proceed to Page 12.

If using Recliner Support System without Soft-Touch® Cushions, skip to Page 14.

Optional:Soft-Touch® Hip-Flex Seat Liner Cushion

Hip-Flex Seat Liner Cushion

Hip-Flex Seat Liner Attachment Strap

If you are not installing the optional Hip-Flex Seat and Back Liners, skip to Page 14.

SL1: Ensure that your Hip-Flex Seat Liner Attachment Strap is at least 52" long in order to be compatible with the Recliner Support System.



SL2: Feed **Crotch Strap** and **Waist Straps** through the respective cutouts in the **Hip-Flex Seat Liner Cushion**.



SL3: Thread **Hip-Flex Seat Liner Attachment Strap** through the lowest **Base Fabric Strap Guide Hole** shown here.



SL4: Feed Hip-Flex
Seat Liner Attachment
Strap behind Base
Fabric Backrest Section
and through the lowest
Strap Guide Hole on the
opposite side. Buckle and
tighten.



Note: Position the **Hip-Flex Seat Liner Attachment Strap**buckle as shown here. Do not let the plastic buckle contact the Recliner Chair fabric to prevent possible scratches.

Optional:Soft-Touch® Back Liner Cushion

Back Liner Attachment Strap

Back Liner Cushion


BL1: Ensure that your **Back Liner Attachment Strap** is at least 52" long in order to be compatible with the **Recliner Support System.**



BL2: Choose a **Base Fabric Strap Guide Hole** at the appropriate height for the occupant, and feed the **Back Liner Attachment Strap** through **Strap Guide Hole** as shown here.



BL3: Pass the **Back Liner Attachment Strap** behind the **Base Fabric Backrest Section** and through the opposite **Strap Guide Hole** as shown here. Clip buckle together.



Note: Once installed, ensure that plastic buckles do not lie directly against Recliner Chair surface to avoid potential scratches.



Note: 5-Point Harness and Pads shown fully-installed here. Refer to steps 18-20 for detailed Harness Pad installation instructions.



can be removed for
an extended or flexed
Headrest position.





22. Feed Headrest
Attachment Straps
through Strap Guide
Holes that best fit the
occupant. Pass Headrest
Attachment Straps
behind Base Fabric
Backrest Section.






23. Thread the Headrest Attachment Straps through the Strap Guide Holes on opposite side of Base Fabric. Clip both buckles next to Headrest Cushion as shown here.



Note: Once installed, ensure that plastic buckles do not lie directly against Recliner Chair surface to avoid potential scratches.

Assembly Calf Cushions



What you'll need for this page:

Calf Cushions Calf Cushion Attachment Straps

24. Feed Calf Cushion Attachment Straps through Strap Guide Holes in Base Fabric Legrest Section that best fit the occupant.



25. Lift Base Fabric Legrest Section and wrap Calf Cushion Attachment Straps around Base Fabric Legrest Section and through opposite Strap Guide Holes as shown here.



26. Clip buckles next to **Calf Cushions** as shown here.



Note: Once installed, ensure that plastic buckles do not lie directly against Recliner Chair surface to avoid potential scratches. What you'll need for this page:

Legrest Securement Strap

27. Lift Base Fabric Legrest Section.



28. Feed end of Legrest Securement Strap through plastic ring on underside of Legrest Section. Then, press Legrest Securement Strap Velcro surfaces together as shown.



29. Lower the **Legrest Section** and wrap **Legrest Securement Strap** under Recliner Chair footrest. Feed the **Legrest Securement Strap** through the opposite plastic ring as shown.



30. Pull **Legrest Securement Strap** tight, then press the Velcro end of the **Legrest Securement Strap** to itself as shown.



5-Point Positioning Harness Adjustment

Use this guide to fit the harness to the occupant in order to optimize comfort and safety.



Always use shoulder pads to prevent plastic buckles and strapping from contacting the occupant's neck and face.

To ensure proper placement of the chest harness, make sure the chest strap lies in the middle of the occupant's chest (armpit level).

The pelvic harness has a single quick-release button that unlocks both sides of the pelvic harness for quick and easy access to the occupant. The quick-release button requires that you push directly in the center of the buckle to release both waist straps at the same time. This is a safety mechanism in case the occupant attempts to release the buckle on their own.

Adjust the length of the crotch strap to allow the pelvic belt to lie across the occupant's pelvis. This will prevent the pelvic belt from lying across the lower abdomen.

The pelvic harness has a cam lock which prevents the waist strap from loosening to maintain proper positioning of the pelvis.



Note: To adjust waist strap length, first push up on webbing to release the cam lock.

Folding for Storage

1. Release the four Securement Straps that wrap around the Recliner Chair. Fold Recliner Drape over Seat Section then place Seat Bight Securement Strap on top of Recliner Drape as shown. Fold in Base Fabric Wings.





2. Fold the **Legrest** and Seat Section up to the Backrest Section. Next, thread the **Legrest Securement Strap** through the top Strap Guide Holes of the Legrest and Backrest (white circles). Next, thread the **Legrest Securement Strap** through the top Strap Guide Holes on opposite side (black circles).





3. Thread the Legrest Securement Strap through the top plastic ring of the Legrest Section as shown, and then back through the Legrest and Backrest Strap Guide Holes. Lastly, press the Legrest Securement Strap Velcro to itself.





Washing Instructions

To prepare Recliner Support System for machine washing, please follow these steps:



2. Remove Fabric Liner Pad.



3. Remove
5-Point
Harness from
Base Fabric.



4. Clip all
5-Point
Harness
buckles
together
as shown
here. Place
5-Point
Harness and
Harness
Pads into
mesh laundry
bag before
washing.



Washing Instructions

5. Remove plastic inserts from zippered pockets in Backrest Section and Legrest Section.

Rezip both pockets.






6. Re-install Fabric Liner Pad to Base Fabric.



7. Remove **Recliner Support System** from Recliner Chair and re-buckle three **Securement Straps** as shown (circled).



- Note: Ensure there is no exposed Velcro hook before washing Recliner Support System.
- Do not put fabric in dryer.
- Wash in cold water with mild detergent on gentle cycle.
- Allow all components to completely air-dry before re-assembly.
- Once all components are completely dry, refer to Page 9 for 5-Point Harness installation instructions.

Warranty & Contact Information

Your Recliner Support System is guaranteed to be free from manufacturing defects for a period of 2 years from the date of purchase. Normal wear-and-tear is not covered. This warranty extends only to the original retail purchaser and is only valid when supplied with proof of purchase. Please retain proof of purchase with this Limited Warranty.

Please contact the retailer where the Recliner Support System was purchased for all service and repair inquiries.

Please note that the Limited Warranty will not be applicable if:

- A fault is caused by misuse or poor maintenance.
- Repairs are carried out by a third party.
- The Recliner Support System is faulty due to general wear and tear resulting from everyday use.
- The Recliner Support System is damaged as a result of an accident.
